## Breadalbane Active Package - A Walker's Paradise

**0930** Meet at Kingshouse Hotel, Balquidder

**1015** Guided Walk

Starting point at Ledcharrie Farm in Glen Dochart, the walk follows the route of an old road marked on Roy's map of 1755 and known as Lairig Earne. The path climbs gently southwards up the valley of the Ledcharrie Burn, passing the ruins of some 15 shelling huts at an altitude of 450 metres. The bealach (col) is reached at an altitude of 600 metres after walking 2.5 miles (4 km). Shortly beyond the bealach lies Lochan an Eireannaich (the small loch of the Irishman), where you will eat your packed lunch, and the enormous rock known as Rob Roy's Putting Stone. From there the route descends through the forest tracks of Kirkton Glen, arriving at Balquidder Church, burial place of Rob Roy MacGregor in 1734. We will end the day with a walk to a welcome plate of stovies and a dram at the Kings House Hotel in Balquidder.
